A request was sent to WIPO from the Ministry of Industry, Trade and Promotion of SMEs of the Republic of Ivory Coast in July 2022 for the development of a Technology and Innovation Support Center (TISCs) network in Abidjan. A positive reply to the request was sent by the WIPO Director General in October 2022 (see attached letters). The activity was planned by WIPO in 2023 but then it was postponed to a later date.

./. A follow-up exchange of emails was carried out by the Director General of the Office Ivoirien de la Propriété Intellectuelle (OIPI) and the Technology and Innovation Support Division to set up a new date for the organization of the workshop on November 27 to 30, 2023 but it was again postponed by WIPO to 2024.

Further to an exchange of telephone calls and a meeting between the delegation of the country and the above-mentioned Division during the Diplomatic Conference on Genetic Resources and Associated Traditional Knowledge, it was proposed to organize the event on July 23 to 26, 2024 in Abidjan.
